It is time to register for this year's **FRANKLIN WESTREK** in Idaho.

Location:

Nampa, ID. Nampa is located 15 miles west of Boise our state Capital. It is a semi-rural area.

Date:

Sunday, June 22, to Friday, June 27, 2008. The temperatures this time of year are usually in the low 50's and the mid 80's.

Sunday registration/Headquarters:

We will hold registration from 3-5pm on Sunday. The first dinner will be served at 6pm.

Tours:

The tours that are planned are diversified and will show you some of Idaho's countryside, high desert land, historical sights, and High Technology. Tour schedule is subject to change.

Sunday, June 22 Registration. Catered dinner at 6pm.

Monday, June 23 Tour the Emmett Valley and the Eagle Winery. We will break for a catered lunch in Emmett. This day will take us through the country and into a Valley full of fruit orchards. Dinner is on your own.

Tuesday, June 24 Tour Lake Lowell, the Warhawk Museum, and the St. Chapelle Winery. We will stop for a catered lunch in Melba. This evening will be a catered dinner sponsored by a company in the area. The company is asking to allow people to see the cars in the parking lot. If you choose to give them rides they will give a donation to be split 50/50 with the Franklin Club/Make a Wish Foundation. More details will be given on this day.

Wednesday, June 25 Touring on this day will take us to the Idaho State Penitentiary and the Idaho Botanical Gardens. We will enjoy a catered lunch in the park at Lucky Peak along the Boise River. Since we are in Idaho you have to have a Baked Potato Bar with all the fixings. Dinner will be on your own.

Thursday, June 26 We will tour the World Center for Birds of Prey, take a drive through our high desert and tour the Swan Falls Dam that sets in a deep canyon. Today's lunch is to be a box lunch that you will pick-up in the morning at the drivers meeting. Tonight is our banquet at 7 pm.

Friday, June 27 This will be a shorter day due to the swap meet, tech session and the hat show for the ladies. We will tour the Micron Technology Plant in Nampa where video chips are made and Amalgamated Sugar home of White Satin Sugar. On this day no dresses, shorts or opened toed shoes will be permitted for safety reasons.

Registration Fee:

Please get your fees in as early as possible so you are not stuck paying a late fee. All luncheons are included and three dinners. The average gas price in the area at this time is \$2.95 and the closest gas station is a ¼ mile from the hotel.

Trailer Park:

The hotel has a vacant lot to the East of the hotel for parking. You will be directed where to park when you arrive on Sunday afternoon. There will be security each evening at the hotel to watch the vintage cars and the tow vehicles.

Antique cars/parking:

Old cars do leak oil, but large puddles of oil are not considered acceptable any longer. Please remember to bring your own cardboard, drip pans, and cat litter if there is a mishap. Please make sure your Franklin is in good running order with reliable brakes. There will be people movers following us if you do happen to break down. We will travel on secondary roads and stay off the freeway.

Clothing

Vintage dress is recommended but not required. Formal attire vintage or modern is required for the Banquet.

Getting to Nampa:

Take Interstate 84, take exit 38 (Garrity), take a right on Flamingo Ave. for the hotel. It is about ¼ mile. The RV Park is on down Garrity about a mile on the Left. They have pull throughs.

If you plan to fly into the area, you will fly into the Boise airport. It is about 20 miles from the hotel.
