• **TOUR OPTION. Best Friends Animal Sanctuary.**

Located 5 miles north of Kanab, Best Friends is the largest no kill animal sanctuary in North America. Home to over 1000 animals such as dogs, cats, horses, rabbits, and other pets, the facility boasts over 1000 acres for rehab and for adoption pets. Animal Planet channel program Dog Town is filmed there.

Due to tour constraints we are NOT scheduling a tour stop. The facility only has 4 daily tours on passenger buses that only hold up to 12-13 individuals. Space is a concern and our group is large.

Note: this is a **FREE** tour. If you have time and are interested, come in early. BOOK NOW and call the tour reservations number at: 435-644-2001, extension 4537 between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm Mountain time. Mention you are with the Franklin Car Club group or Westrek and they will group you together with other Westrek persons.

The tour lasts 90 minutes & begins promptly at 9 am, 10:30 am, 1:30 pm and 3 pm Mountain time. Check in at the Welcome Center 30 minutes before your tour starts. You will get out of the tour bus for a short visit in both a dog and cat building. See their website for other tours for the other animal houses. They also invite you to volunteer to participate with the regular routine of animal care – feeding, cleaning, grooming, walking, etc.

You must purchase your own national park pass on your own. The following passes are available to purchase online or at any national park entrance.

A pass covers entrance & standard amenity fees for a driver & all passengers in a personal vehicle at per vehicle fee areas (or up to 4 adults at sites that charge per person). Children age 15 or under are admitted free.

- Annual Pass \$80.00
- Senior Pass \$10.00 for US citizens age 62 & over
- Access Pass is Free for US citizens with permanent disabilities.

Golden Access and Golden Age Passports are no longer sold. However, these passes will continue to be honored according to the provisions of the pass.
