September 16th – 19th
(Wed.16th – Registration)

Host city: Oshkosh , Wisconsin. Founded in 1853. Population 67,242.

Oshkosh sits along the western shores of Lake Winnebago and banked by the Fox River. We will visit some of the city's most famous sites and enjoy beautiful tours on paved roads. You might want to try Wisconsin's popular deep-fried cheese curds, German-style beer brats, and frozen custard desserts!

September 17th, Day 1 - Thursday

Wisconsin Automotive Museum, approximately \$15 per person. Located in Hartford, WI, home of Kissel Car Company. Approximately 112 miles round trip including a stop at Hartford Scoop DeVille Ice Cream Parlor. On the return trip, we will visit the EAA Museum in Oshkosh. 1.5 miles from the hotel. Approximately \$15 per person.

September 18th, Day 2 - Friday

Miller Electric Plant tour in Appleton, WI. Approximately 46 miles round trip including a stop at famous Leons Frozen Custard for ice cream and burgers. We will visit the Paine Art Center and Gardens and the Oshkosh Public Museum. The Art Center/Gardens is approximately \$15 per person and the Public Museum is approximately \$10 per person.

September 19th, Day 3 - Saturday

FWD/Seagrave Fire Truck Museum in Clintonville, birthplace of the Four Wheel Drive concept. Round trip approximately 100 miles. Approximately \$15 per person. Return trip will include a stop at Erickson's Dairy Farm – near Clintonville. The banquet will be at The Roxy, a classic Wisconsin supper club in Oshkosh, 571 N. Main Street.
